Your project drawings must illustrate the following:


- 1. Please include the property address and the name of the property owner.
- 2. Your drawing should illustrate the location of all the property lines, the primary structure, and any existing accessory structures on the property.
- 3. Please show the placement of any existing or proposed fence and clearly show the distance from all property lines to the proposed fence. If the fence will be placed directly on the property line please show that on your plot plan.
- 4. Include any adjacent streets to the property and the names of those streets.
- 5. Please note the length of each section of fence to be installed on the plot plan.

Please Note:

- Fences may be no taller than eight (8) feet in the side or rear yard of a property.
- ✓ Fences no taller than 42" may be located in the front yard (if you have a more unique shape lot, such as a corner lot, you may have what is considered multiple front yards.)
- ✓ Please note that any land existing between the fence to the edge of the property line must be maintained by the
