Village Income Tax Assistance

The 2018 Covington income tax forms have been mailed to Covington residents. If you have any questions regarding Village income tax or questions about the income tax forms, please contact the St. Mary's Department of Taxation at 419/394-3303. Their hours are 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday through Friday.

Staff from the Department of Taxation will be at the Government Center in Covington to assist residents with questions on Saturday, March 30th from 10 A.M. to 1 P.M., Tuesday April 2nd from 1 to 4 P.M., and Thursday, April 11th from 6 to 8 P.M.

Please bring your W-2s and a copy of your federal tax return. (1040 form)

To avoid penalties, completed income tax forms must be received at the St. Mary's Department of Taxation no later than **April 15, 2019**. The Department of Taxation's address is 106 E. Spring Street, St. Mary's Ohio 45885-2363

The current income tax rate for Covington remains at 1.5%. Please note that effective 1/1/2019 the income tax credit given to Covington residents that pay income tax to other municipalities has been reduced to ½ percent.

If you live in Covington, and pay income tax to another municipality, please contact your employer to determine if they will voluntarily withhold Covington income tax for you.
