Notes for the Month of August and Beyond:

- The **High Street Utilities Project** is complete. Thank you all for your patience during the process. The next ODOT project is anticipated to begin in May 2022 which includes final paving and sidewalks.
- The **Face Street Pavement project** is complete. Check it out when you are stopping by the BOM for August – Sweet Treats.
- The Old Rudy Elevator was purchased by the Village last month. The site has been secured and “No Trespassing” signs are being put up. The Village is currently obtaining funding to demolish the building.
- The **Schoolhouse Park project** has held two open houses (June 28 and July 27) to get input on the future park. The Council is set to approve the plan on August 16 at their regularly scheduled meeting.
- The Village has gone out for bid for the design of a new Wastewater Treatment Facility. Bids will be returned in August.
