Notes for the Month of December and Beyond:

- The Village has three new Council members – Julie Blumenstock, Derrick Canan, and Amy Welborn. Dawn Duff was reelected to Council. All four will be sworn in on January 3, 2022 for their 4 year terms.
- The December **Holiday Schedule** will be the following: December 24 and December 31 the Government Center will be closed in observance of Christmas and New Year's Day. Trash Service will not be delayed.
- **Curbside Leaf Pickup** will continue into December. The Village purchased a new one-man leaf pick up attachment to allow for Village staff to be more efficient and unfortunately many of the parts have been back ordered for months. Village staff has been utilizing the street sweeper but will utilize both the street sweeper and leaf vacuum to complete pick up in December.
- **Additional Trash Pick-Up.** The Village will provide free additional pick up of **bagged trash** at no additional charge during the week of December 27th. Free pick-up does not include furniture, mattresses, appliances, or other large items, only additional bagged trash that may not fit within your standard trash toter due to the holiday. Large item pick up will still be charged per normal rates. Please call the Village with any questions.
