Covington Council Sets Dates for Public Hearings

The Covington Council has set the dates and times for the following public hearings.

The first public hearing is set for July 15 at 7:00 PM. This public hearing is to review a request for a zoning map amendment for a property located at 226 N. High Street. If approved as proposed the zoning of this property would be changed from R1-residential to NB- neighborhood business.

The second public hearing is set for August 19th at 7:00 PM. The purpose of this public hearing is to obtain public comments for a proposed downtown renovation district. If approved, this district would allow 70% of increases in tax valuation within the proposed downtown renovation district to be placed in a fund to be used for the redevelopment of, and to promote business activity within the downtown area.

Public participation at these public hearings is welcomed and encouraged.

Low Volume Trash is Now Available

Beginning July 1st, 2019 Covington residents can opt to receive a smaller 48 gallon trash toter instead of the current 96 gallon toter. Residents choosing to utilize the smaller trash toter will be charged a monthly fee of \$14.75 per month, a \$2.00 monthly discount from the regular trash service rate. Please contact the Covington Government Center after July 1st to request the low volume trash service.
