Village of Covington Street Maintenance

This past winter has taken a toll on area roadways. Covington's streets are no exception. With the rising cost of street resurfacing, and the reduction of funding from the State of Ohio, Covington's needs for street resurfacing have outpaced our ability to keep up.

The Village does not currently have a dedicated levy for street maintenance. In contrast, West Milton and Union have 3 mill levies for street maintenance; Bradford has a 7-mill levy.

The Covington Council began discussing options for funding our street resurfacing program last year. The council decided to place a 3-mill, 5-year levy on the May 8, 2018 ballot for your consideration. If passed this 3-mill levy will cost a person with a home valued at \$100,000 approximately \$52.50 per half or 29 cents per day. This levy, if passed, will generate approximately \$124,000 annually that will be used strictly to maintain Covington village streets.

We hope you agree that we have a need to make our streets better and support this levy on May 8^{th} .

Covington Community Food Truck Rally

The Miami Valley Music Festival is sponsoring a Covington community food truck rally on Saturday May 12, 2018 from 11:00 AM to 7:00 PM. This event will feature area food trucks as well as live music. The Miami Valley Music Festival Group will also be selling cold beer as a fundraiser. Please come out and enjoy this new event.
