Leaf pickup is well underway. Residents are asked to rake their leaves to the street and place them in the curb lawn area for pickup. Village staff will continue to pick up the leaves as their schedule allows through the end of November. During the leaf pickup season yard waste may be placed unbagged curb-side with the leaves. Village crews will vacuum this yard waste up with the leaves and take it to be composted. Once the leaf season is completed, residents are asked to return to the use of biodegradable paper yard waste bags

## **November Holiday Schedule**

**Daylight Savings Time** - Daylight Savings time begins on Sunday, November 1, 2020 @ 2:00 A.M. Remember to set your clocks back before you go to bed on Saturday Night.
