

RESOLUTION R32-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO  
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FRYMAN-KUCK FOR THE SOUTH  
END PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Covington has determined that the South End Pump Station located in the Village is in need of improvements, including but not limited to, the replacement of existing pumps, controls and the installation of a backup generator system;

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator solicited bids for the South End Pump Station Improvement Project;

WHEREAS, Fryman – Kuck General Contractors INC. submitted a bid to complete said project and its bid was the lowest and best bid;

WHEREAS, OPWC requires the Village to tentatively award the project pending the OPWC loan program's approval;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the legislative authority of the Village of Covington, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1: The Council of the Village of Covington hereby tentatively awards the South End Pump Station Improvement Project to Fryman – Kuck General Contractors pending approval from the OPWC loan program.

Section 2: The Village Administrator of the Village of Covington is authorized to enter into the contract with Fryman – Kuck General Contractors INC. for the completion of the South End Pump Station Improvement Project and Issue a notice to proceed for the project.

Section 3: this ordinance shall be in effect at the earliest period of time as permitted by law.
