The following is the School Resource Officer Report for February 2018.

February continued our busy winter sports season. In addition to our girls and boys basketball and wrestling, Covington High School hosted the Division III Girls Basketball Sectional Tournament, and the Southwest District Wrestling Sectional Tournament.

With School Safety being a big topic of discussion across the nation following the Parkland, FL school shooting, I thought I would take some time to discuss some of the things that Covington Exempted Village School District does to help make Covington Schools as safe of an environment as possible. The biggest step, and most expensive, was the upgrade of the District Facilities themselves. My first year as the SRO, our students and staff were spread out in three separate, aging facilities. All of these buildings were built without the thought of having to protect students from egregious acts of violence. In the 2016-2017 school year, we opened our new K-8 facility. This new facility has some of the most up to date safety features, the likes of which have never been in a Covington School.

This new facility has an electronic entry system, this system has card readers at every entry door, which also tracks everyone who swipes into the building, what time they entered and which door they entered. This system also allows the District IT and Administration to set restrictions on building entry. For example, the majority of staff members are not able to access the building in the middle of the night and we are able to deactivate or greatly restrict coaches' cards following their season finishing. This feature also allows us to deactivate a lost or stolen card to deny entry to the building unlike with a standard key.

The new building also has a high quality camera system installed throughout the building and around the exterior. This system has the ability to be remotely accessed and monitored by certain members of the administration and safety team at Covington Schools.

The main entry at the K-8 facility, requires a visitor to enter a secure vestibule and "buzz" into the office, with access granted, or denied, by the Elementary Secretary who is able to have a direct line of site to the person requesting access. This is an upgrade to the previous buildings, as they relied on a camera view to identify the visitor.

For the 2017-2018 School Year, we added more features, specifically the corridor to connect the High School to the K-8 Building and the camera system in the High School. The High School has had a camera system for many years now, however, these cameras were far outdated as technology has progressed. For this school year, the District installed a camera system that ties into the existing system in the K-8 facility.

While these have been excellent strides, the District Administration, School Board and Covington Police Department, continuously work to identify ways to continue to improve the overall safety and security of our students, staff and facilities. Upcoming projects include the replacement of all entry doors in the High School, some of these doors are original to the building. Along with the doors, the High School will be placed on the same electronic entry system as the rest of the campus.

In addition to improving the safety and security through facilities improvements, we have also implemented the A.L.I.C.E. Incident Response Protocol, this stands for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter and Evacuate. Prior to implementing A.L.I.C.E., Covington Schools had the standard "Lockdown Only Protocol," which said if there was an active shooter or some other emergency, the only option was to lock the classroom door, turn off the lights, hide in the corner of the classroom and be quiet. The Lockdown Only Protocol has been removed, however A.L.I.C.E. still allows for Lockdown in some instances. One of those times is if the threat is nearby, however, it encourages more than just locking the door. We teach our staff and students to barricade the door, to make their room nearly impossible to enter or very time consuming to do so. In a situation such as an active shooter, the potential victims need to buy as much time as possible to allow law enforcement to find, engage, and end the threat. Other times that we still use lockdown are: medical emergencies to keep the hallways clear for emergency personnel, K-9 Unit drug sweeps, and potential external threats (such as significant, nearby police activity). During these incidents, class continues as normal, but nobody is permitted in the hallways. The Counter portion of A.L.I.C.E. teaches, and encourages, our staff and students, to not be "sitting ducks" if an active shooter enters their room prior to them being able to Lockdown or Evacuate. This does not teach them to "fight" the threat, but to make enough of a distraction to give them the opportunity to evacuate. The biggest thing we teach is find an object and throw it at the threat, this buys the potential victims time to put distance between them and the threat. Evacuate, this is what our number one priority is for our students and staff. Get out of the building. The threat is inside, so get outside and move as far away from the building as possible, as quick as possible.

Unfortunately, no matter what any school district, community or law enforcement agency does, there is always potential for school violence to occur. However, we work daily to ensure that we make the Covington Schools a safe and welcoming environment for all of our staff, students and visitors. However, we are not of the belief that we know everything there is to know about the topic, we are always welcoming to suggestions and thoughts from the community.

During February, Covington High School hosted two High School Boys Basketball Games, Friday the 2nd hosting Ansonia and Friday the 9th hosting Newton. The Girls Basketball team hosted two games as well, the 1st against National Trail and the 8th against Tri-County North. On the 17th, 21st, 22nd, and 27th Covington hosted a Sectional Tournament for Division III Girls Basketball and then on the 23rd and 24th we hosted a Sectional Tournament for Wrestling.

On the 23rd, 26th and 27th, Covington Elementary Guidance Counselor Jim Meyer and I were guests in our Sixth Grade classes to discuss Bullying with those students and also had them all take an anonymous survey to try to find any bullying issues that the students feel exist in their grade and school in general. It was fairly positive, as the majority of students responded that they had not been a victim of bullying in the past year, and the majority of those who stated that they had been a victim, it was not a daily event and that when they reported the bullying, it was stopped by a staff member.
