#### To: Chief Lee Harmon

The following is the May 2017 School Resource Officer Monthly Report:

May was the last month of school for the Covington Exempted Village School District. Therefore, it is a very busy time as Academics are finishing up, Final Exams are being held, Spring Sports are finishing up, everyone is looking forward to moving up a grade level and the Seniors are looking forward to Graduation. We had numerous special events this month, as well as a few SRO Presentations for students.

On Tuesday, May 2, I was joined by Covington Elementary Principal Rick Fry as we taught the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades the A.L.I.C.E. Emergency Protocol. With these two grades being taught, that made all current Covington Students taught in this Protocol.

On Monday, May 8, the Covington Police Department hosted a town hall meeting with the Miami County Heroin Coalition at the Covington K-8 Building. This was attended by over 70 citizens from Covington and the surrounding area. This involved a panel discussion of experts from various fields, a question and answer session and also a brief overview of the local problems.

On Tuesday, May 9, I was invited into Mr. Comstock's 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Health Class to give a presentation on Abuse. During this presentation the students are taught about the different types of abuse, including: physical, emotional, neglect and substance abuse.

On Wednesday, May 10, I assisted the Covington High School National Honor Society with their morning "Roadblock" fundraiser. During this year's Roadblock, they were able to raise nearly \$300 for charity. Later in the afternoon, the Covington Exempted Village Schools held their first ever A.L.I.C.E. Drill, instead of the traditional Lockdown Drill. During this drill, we proceeded in blocks of grades for age appropriate responses. We began in the High School, identified a location of a threat that made students and staff decide whether to barricade or evacuate, then the threat moved, allowing the remainder to evacuate. The same was done in the Junior High wing at the K-8 building. In the Elementary, there was an "unknown situation" in the far end of the building, allowing all 6 grades to evacuate. The purpose of this drill was to help the students learn how and where we will evacuate to in an emergency where A.L.I.C.E. is put into action.

On Tuesday, May 16, I was invited into the 6<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms to give a presentation on Alcohol and Drug Abuse. During this presentation, students are taught the basics about alcohol, illegal drugs and prescription drugs. This includes, the original purpose of the drugs and the effects they have on the body.

In the afternoon on Tuesday, May 16, a tragedy struck Covington High School, the entire district and community as a whole. High School Senior Jaret VanHoose was killed in a motor vehicle accident just outside of town. I responded to the accident along with Chief Harmon, Miami County Sheriff's Office and Covington Fire and Rescue. Unfortunatley, despite valiant efforts made by all on scene, Jaret was unable to survive his injuries. Upon leaving the accident scene, I returned to Covington High School, where I met with Superintendent Gene Gooding, High School Guidance Counselor Karen Brackman, High School Secretary Stephanie Robinson, and K-8 Guidance Counselor Jim Meyer. We worked throughout the remainder of the afternoon and into the late evening determining what our best course of action would be for all of our students and staff, but especially our senior class, who's last day is Wednesday, May 17.

During our time working on the plans, Chief Harmon as well as Miami County Victim Witness were on site assisting with our decisions.

Wednesday, May 17, was the hardest day I have had in my position as School Resource Officer at Covington Schools. We opened the high school gym to our senior class for them to be together during this difficult time. There, they were met with school guidance staff, administrators, local clergy, grief counselors of the Tri-County Crisis Response Team, as well as myself. There were many tears, hugs and questions, which many could not be answered. I was informed by the counselors, prior to students arriving, that high school students typically will not talk to counselors or other adults, but they are here to help anyone that we see as having an especially difficult time. Throughout the day, I had many seniors come up and interact with me, at one point I was asked by three seniors to sit with them at a table. I was later approached by members of the CRT, who asked me if I realized how many students I had with me. I told them I did not, they informed me that at one point around a 2ft by 6ft table, I had 17 students seated or standing around me. The CRT members told me that it was the first time all day that they had seen any of the seniors smile or laugh, and that there was a lot of that occurring in the group that was with me. I do not mention this to "blow my own horn," but to show how vital a School Resource Officer is to our students. The SRO is not there as a teacher, the SRO is not there as a disciplinarian, the SRO is not there to keep the threat out of our schools, although, those are all important roles for the SRO. The SRO is there to become a mentor, a role model, a person that the students can come to and when needed, a shoulder to cry on. This day, and days like it, is what makes this position such a vital and necessary position in our Police Department and School System. With that being said, I never want to experience another day like May 16 and 17<sup>th</sup>.

On Tuesday, May 23, was the annual Covington Elementary Field Day. The day was beautiful and the students, staff and parents had a wonderful time outdoors engaging in many fun games and activities. Also, in the afternoon and evening of May 23, the Covington High School Gym hosted the viewing for Jaret. This event was heavily attended by students, staff, parents and members of the community as a whole to come and show support and sympathy for Jaret's family.

On Wednesday, May 24, Chief Harmon, Officer Blei, members of the School Administration and I attended Jaret's Funeral at the Covington Church of the Brethren.

On Thursday, May 25, Covington Elementary hosted their annual End of Year Awards Assembly. This is the second year that the Covington Police Department and the Covington Noon Optimist Club has held a drawing for two students who have been awarded a "Character Counts Award" (think student of the month). These two students are given a brand new bicycle, helmet and bike lock. This year's winners were Mary Larson and Allison Jay, but were extremely excited for their new bikes.

Friday, May 26, was the last day of school for the Covington Exempted Village School District. I assisted High School Guidance Counselor Karen Brackman and High School Principal Josh Long with the Senior Class's Graduation Practice at Covington High School and finally at Hobart Arena in Troy, OH. It was exciting to be with such a great group of students as they practiced for the event that they have worked 13 long years for.

On Sunday, May 28, I was able to attend the Covington High School Graduation Ceremony at Hobart Arena. It was a wonderful ceremony to celebrate an excellent class. I also have had the privilege to be invited to, and attend, many Graduation Parties for our outgoing seniors. They are a great group of students who will be missed by many.

To finish up the report, I will briefly cover the May Spring Sports Events. On Tuesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, I assisted with the Junior High Track Invitational. This event brought in 12 teams to compete as well as many spectators. We had no incidents during the meet. Our High School Track Invitation was cancelled due to foul weather, however a "Quad-Meet" was scheduled for Monday, May 8. I assisted with this until I had to leave for the Heroin Coalition Town Hall. On Saturday, May 13, our High School Softball Team held a make-up game against Franklin Monroe, which was also "Senior Day" for the 5 seniors. On Saturday, May 20, I travelled to Mason High School in Mason, OH to watch our softball team play in the District Finals. Unfortunately, our team lost, but they had an excellent season.
