2023 Village Updates!

- The **2023 State of Village** address will occur at the January 23rd Meeting. Come to the meeting to hear all the great things that happened in 2022 and all the goals for 2023!
- **Schoolhouse Park Project** – The Village has begun the demolition of the Old Rudy Property and is going out for bid in January for the development of the remainder of the park!
- **Wastewater Treatment Facility** – The Village was made aware that WPCLF has ranked Covington as the #2 project in the State and will award \$4,000,000 in loan forgiveness for the construction of the WWTP. The Village will be working with the State to confirm overall loan rates and anticipates bidding the project in March, 2023. This is a huge win for the Village.
- **High Street Lights** – The Village anticipates the streetlights and traffic lights for the High Street project to be delivered at the end of January with a February installation.
- **Covington Sign** – The Village installed the new COVINGTON sign before the Village Hometown Christmas event in December. The sign cost less than the estimated replacement cost of a digital sign, was constructed and built by local companies (thank you FabTech!), and has created a unique buzz for the Village in local newspapers and social media.
- **New Dropbox** – The Village also has a new black dropbox at the Government Center. It is located in same area as the old dropbox, and is clearly labeled.
