Project Updates

- **Wastewater Plant Project** – The new WWTP project has begun with lots of work occurring on the site including removal of a substantial amount of dirt! The project is anticipated to last roughly 18-24 months. Once completed the Village will have a state of the art SBR facility along with an administration building to serve the needs of the Public Works and Utilities Departments!
