Project Updates

- <u>Wastewater Treatment Plant Project</u> The project has started with the removal of trees along Covington-Gettysburg. The majority of the project will begin later in May.
- <u>Schoolhouse Park</u> The Village continues to move forward with Schoolhouse Park with Phase 1 Site Work starting in May. This phase of the project includes the removal of Maple Street and Grant Street, the regrading of the property, and movement of utilities. The Village will be going out for bid for the construction of the pavilion / bathroom and splashpad in May.

- Roadway Pavement The Village is contracting with Wagner Pavement to mill and fill SR41 and US36 in areas that greatly need attention. This short-term fix will hopefully make the situation better, but the long-term solution is to completely rebuild the roadway. The Village has received funding through ODOT for US36 repairs in 2028. No funding is currently available for full SR41 repairs.
- <u>Community Park</u> Opening day is happening! The Park looks beautiful with newly painted bathrooms, new lighting, cleaned up playgrounds, new rock around the bleachers, and much more. The Village continues to invest in our parks and public spaces!
