RESOLUTION R01-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO REQUEST QUALIFICATIONS FOR DESIGN, ARCHITECTURAL, AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR AN ADDITION AND REMODEL TO THE VILLAGE OF COVINGTON GOVERNMENT CENTER

WHEREAS, the Village of Covington has done a comprehensive review and needs assessment related to the Government Center and found there are substantial deficiencies related to health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Covington hired Candace Goodall to review the building, make suggestions, and provide preliminary draft concepts to develop a plan for remodel; and

WHEREAS, during the process of review it was determined that the Village Government Center was inadequate in multiple ways, including having a Council Chambers that does not meet the needs of the Village moving forward, including size requirements, technology requirements, and safety requirements; and

WHEREAS, based on the initial preliminary design discussions, it was determined that the Village needs to request qualifications of a design, architectural, and engineering firm that has the expertise to help create formal design documents related to the remodel of the government center; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Covington, Ohio:



SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is authorized to advertise a Request for Qualifications for Design, Architectural, and Engineering Services for an Addition and Remodel to the Village of Covington Government Center at a do not exceed cost of \$150,000 which is reflected within the 2023 Budget; and

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after the earliest period allowed by law.
