SECTION 1: the Council of the Village of Covington is hereby declaring the items listed in the attached Exhibit A obsolete and as surplus; and


SECTION 2: the Village Administrator is authorized to sell via internet auction on Gov Deals, scrap, or dispose of the items listed in the attached Exhibit A; and
