RESOLUTION R34-23

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ENGINEERING AGREEMENT WITH KLEINFELDER FOR DESIGN AND INSPECTION SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Covington hired a consultant – Poggemeyer Design Group, to help create a master plan for Schoolhouse Park which was adopted by the Village Council of Covington in August, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village entered into an agreement with Poggemeyer Design Group for architectural and engineering services related to Schoolhouse Park under Resolution R11-22 for \$41,000 and subsequently increased the agreement by \$4,951.50, which has been expended; and

**WHEREAS**, Poggemeyer Design Group is now called Kleinfelder; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Covington is in need of additional inspection services for the Schoolhouse Park – Main Pavilion / Splashpad Phase from Kleinfelder and needs to increase the contractual amount by a do not exceed amount of \$20,000 for inspection services related to that project; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Covington, Ohio:

**Section 1.** The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into the engineering agreement between the Village of Covington and Kleinfelder, as noted in Exhibit A, which includes a not to exceed amount of \$20,000 for inspection services related to the Schoolhouse Park – Main Pavilion / Splashpad project making the new total agreement cost \$65,951.50; and

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earlier period allowed by law.


