RESOLUTION R18-23

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO DISPOSE OF SAID PROPERTY BY TRADE-IN, AUCTION, DISPOSAL OR DESTRUCTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief of the Village of Covington, Ohio (“Village”) has recommended to Council that the Police Department property listed in “Exhibit A” is surplus property no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, and unfit for the use for which it was acquired and items seized as evidence of a crime by the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, all items that have no value to the Village of Covington Police Department as listed in Exhibit A will be traded in; and

**WHEREAS**, the eight weapons will be traded in for a total value of \$2,240 in credit to Vance’s Law Enforcement to go towards the purchase of future weapons; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Covington, Ohio:

**Section 1.** The Village Council finds that items of personal property of the Village and declared approved for trade-in, sale, auction or destruction, set forth in the attached “Exhibit A”, are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired, and thus are surplus property and available for disposition.

**Section 2.** The Mayor or his designee is authorized and directed to dispose of the surplus property by sale, trade-in or destruction of said property.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
