

VILLAGE PROJECT UPDATES

High Street Project

- Final Stages of Project with Phases 1-3 complete!
- The last phase, which is scheduled for the beginning of September, will be the final topcoat of asphalt, striping, and all remaining signs, lights, and poles will be installed once we procure them.

Schoolhouse Park Project

- A groundbreaking was held on August 31 for the Park!
- Bidding for the project went out the end of August in 3 bids – Phase 1 Improvements, Phase 1 Site Modifications, and the Rudy Property.
- Bids will be opened on September 14 and a bidder will be accepted at the Village Council meeting on September 19th.
- The Village will be holding a public auction of building memorabilia for Schoolhouse Park in late September!

Wastewater Treatment Facility

- The Village has applied to the WPCLF. This is a funding source through the Ohio EPA that allows the Village to be granted principal forgiveness (a reduction on the potential debt), low or no interest loans (down to 0% loans for 45 years), and other potential reductions in the cost of the project.
- We will know in mid-October or early November if the Village was fortunate enough to get funding for the project or what rate we qualify for the project.
- The Village will hold meetings related to the financial structures required once we know how the Village scores in the WPCLF process.
