COVINGTON VILLAGE COUNCIL

Covington Village Council met in a regular meeting on September 6, 2016 at the Village office at 1 S. High St. Covington. Mayor Ed McCord called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The following roll call was taken for council:

The council packet included minutes from the 08/15/16 meeting, Village Administrator report, and the bill packets including checks #9732-9769.

Agenda:

A motion was made by Newman and seconded by Robertson to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Minutes:

The minutes from the 08/15/16 meeting were approved as read.

Mayor's Report:

Mayor McCord updated Council on his weekly meetings and activities. Also, the Mayor informed Council of the following:

Public Hearings for Gas and Electric aggregation will be held on September 19th and October 17th at 6:30 p.m.

Fort Rowdy Ham and Bean and Chili Dinner will be held Saturday, 9/10/16, from 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

Formal dedication of the new K-8 school building will be held Sunday, 9/11/16, at 2 PM.

Village Administrator Report-the following topics were addressed:

Water Tower Renovation

The tower has been refilled and is back in service. A little yard maintenance and seeding need to be done when we have time.

Safe Routes to School

ODOT has been contacted about this project but a date for the preconstruction meeting has not been set.

St Rt 36 Speed Study

Mr. Busse spoke with Craig at Choice One who feels the Village has a good chance at getting the speed limit reduced to 40 MPH but was uncertain about our chances of getting it reduced to 35 MPH. Mr. Busse told Craig the Village would wait and see how the traffic flows before proceeding with a speed study.

ODOT does not have specific criteria for determining if a speed limit should be lowered but waits for information obtained by a speed study.

Trash and Recycling Toters

Included in Council's packet is a proposal for the lease of additional trash and recycling toters, and we have budgeted \$10,000 for this year. Requesting Council consider purchasing additional trash and recycling toters, and financing them over the next two years. Council instructed Mr. Busse to proceed in obtaining a quote.

Utility Service Truck

Recommending to Council that we purchase a 2017 Ford F250 pickup from Middletown Ford in the amount of \$26,665.84 utilizing the State of Ohio cooperative purchasing program.

Also recommending to Council that we purchase a service body for this truck in the amount of \$5,500.00 from KE Rose. The total cost is \$\$32,165.84, and this is a budgeted item through the water and sewer funds. This will replace a 2001 Dodge service truck.

Wagner Paving

Steven Street and Chestnut Street between Steven and Debra have been repaved. Requesting Council approve the amendment of the contract price from \$49,898.00 to \$48,329.15, and vote to approve the payment to Wagner Paving.

136 N. High Street

136 N. High Street has been demolished and the lot has been seeded. Requesting Council approve the payment of \$9,400.00 to M&T Excavating for the teardown.

2016 Sidewalk Project

Requesting Council amend the original contract amount from \$25,426.00 to \$31,610.79 for M&T Excavating. Increase is due to a change in actual quantities of work completed during the project, most of which will be assessed to the property owners.
